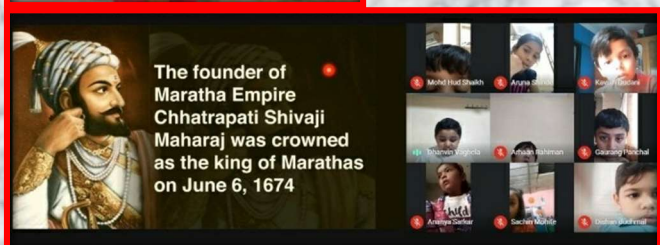
Shivaji Jayanti Celebration

Zumba Activity

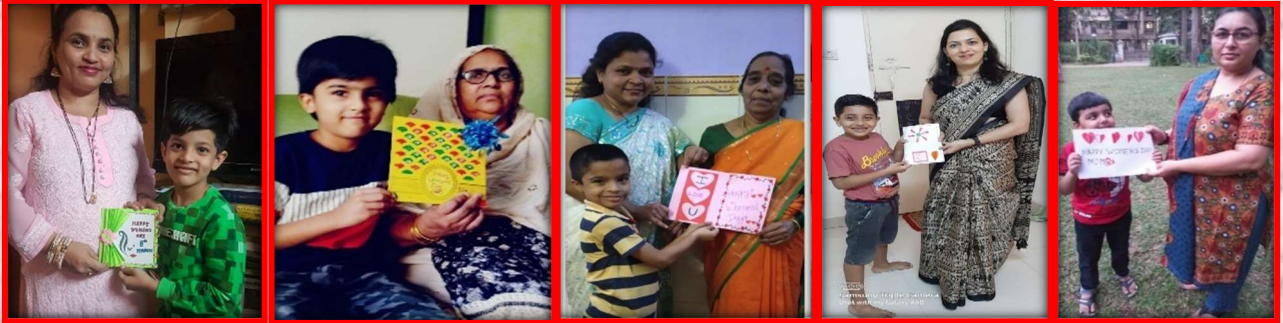


Zumba is a fun aerobic workout that mixes in dance moves.

GREEN BRIGADE ACTIVITY

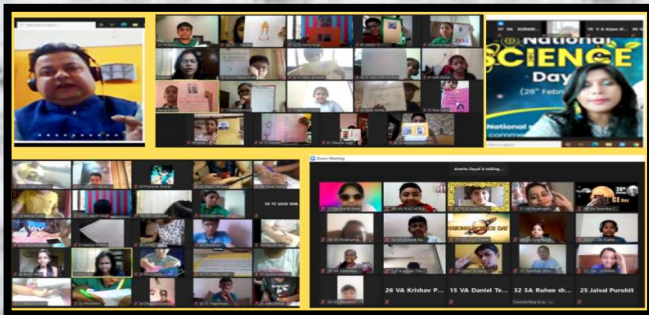


Our Campus is the NO.1 School in Mumbai in the plastic recycling campaign. So far, we have collected 645kgs and looking forward for more.

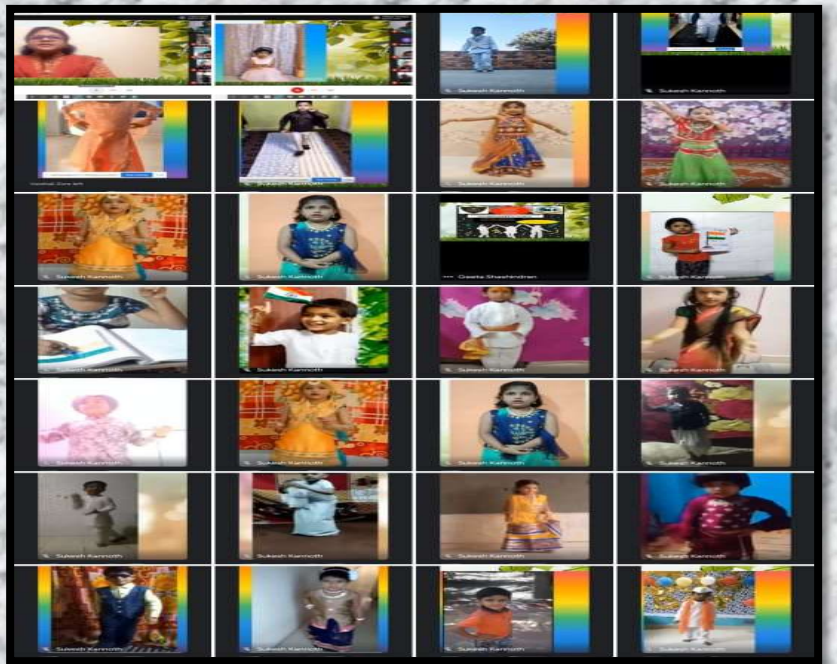
ANNUAL DAY

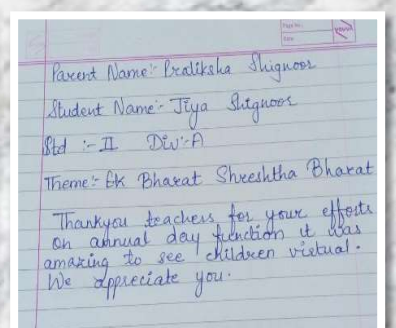
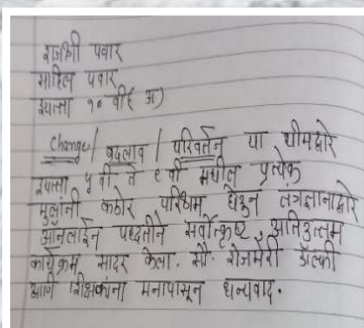
