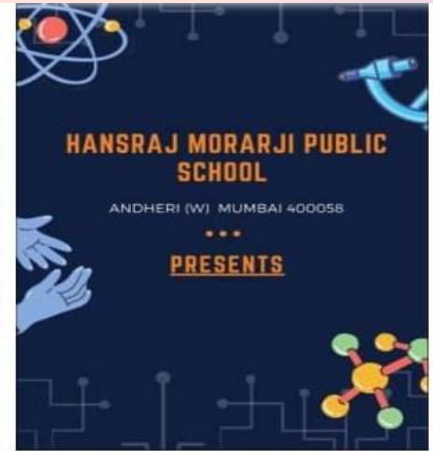
Green Brigade Tide Turners Programme

The Harit Club of HMPS School, Andheri West, Mumbai 400058 participated in the Tide Turners online certification programme along with a Guide Teacher, A Guide Parent and 15 students.

The Guide Teacher is Ms. Mitali Mehta and the Guide Parent is Ivan A. Sequeira. All in all we had a great time doing the worksheet for a week since we were already used to collecting plastic for the last 1years. Our Green Brigade is actively involved in this exercise. The Tide Turner participants were encouraged to deposit plastic and motivate others in their online class sessions. Our objective from the start was to foster a sense of belonging to a long term venture where giving plastic ultimately became a part of our lives and indeed it has become. The process involved depositing plastic once a week at our school entrance and then it would be picked up by the vendor for processing. We also pick up plastic from select pickup points convenient to the kids residence. Our School has a MOU with Bisleri for recycling the plastic. In all since the start of recycling we have given 1800 kgs till date and we are very proud to state that all this has been recycled at Bisleri end. We have in the process established Green Brigades in other schools in our campus using our experience in plastic recycling. We have designed a HMPS CAMPUS GREEN BRIGADE cap and reward our regular contributors selectively with the CAP.

The Tide Turners contest has enabled our kids to get a focus in the way a competition is run very systematically. We did a google survey with a response from close to 660 individuals. We managed to create a lot of awareness and motivation for the recycling cause. Our future GOALS includes all the 4 schools functioning as one cohesive unit, motivating other schools in our area (we are talking to schools right now) and planning to collect 5000 kgs by December 2021. On its part, Bisleri has rewarded the school with a bench made from 40 kgs of recycled plastic. Also in the works are many more recycled products. We have sourced samples of paver blocks to make a " plastic road " in the campus. Eagerly awaiting the return of kids in normal times to make this recycling campaign a way of life. The Tide Turners programme has given our kids a sense of purpose, dedication and discipline in the period that we were working on it.

Thank you for your guidance and well timed mission. We eagerly look forward to taking part in the next installment of Tide Turners Programmers.

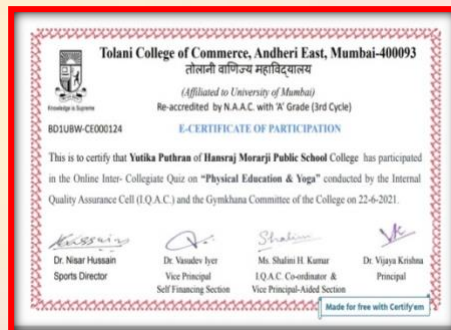


VIRTUAL SPACE EXHIBITION

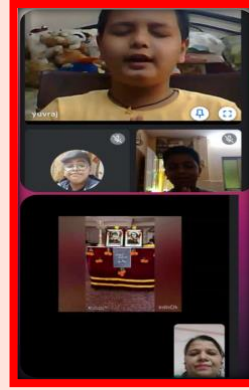
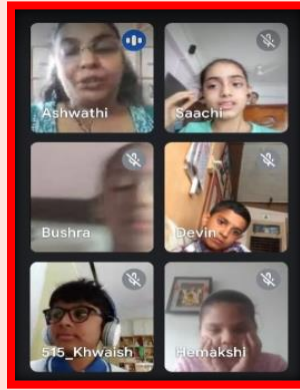
HMPS INTERACT CLUB

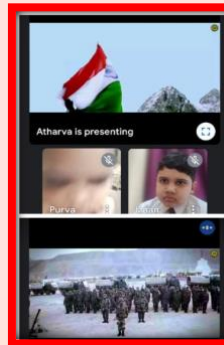
PRIMARY SECTION

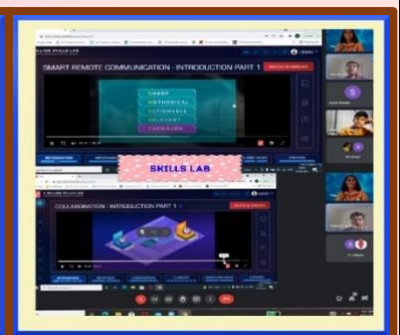


SKILLS LAB

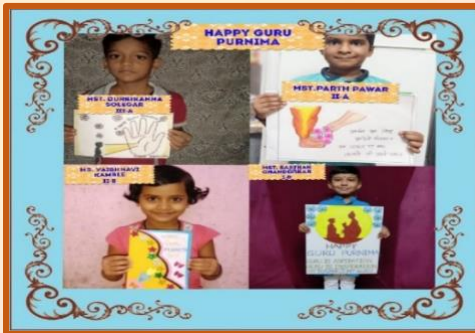
BUILDING NEST

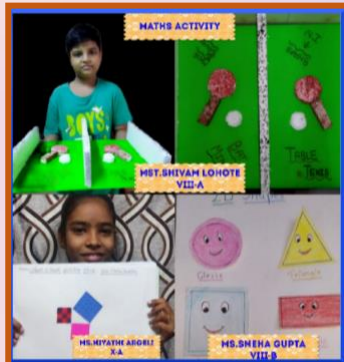

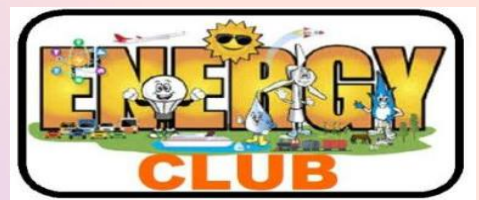

Car logos and brand names of the same were introduced to the students. To conclude the activity, they were asked to draw and colour the logo of their favourite car as taught by the teacher in the online session.

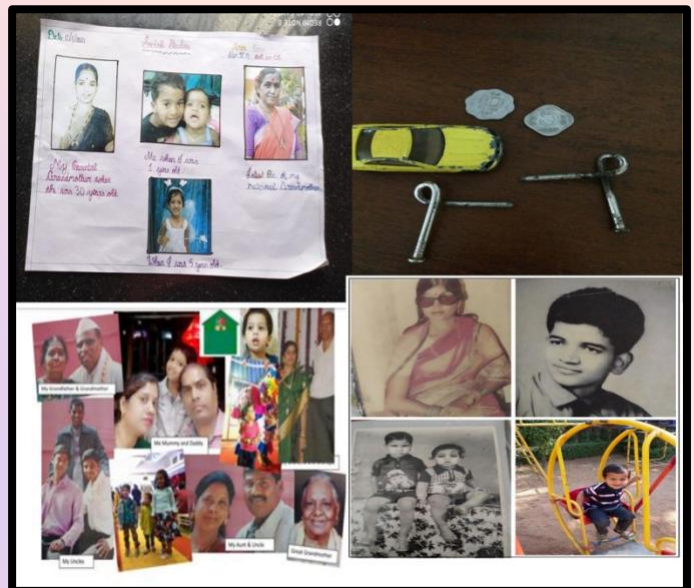

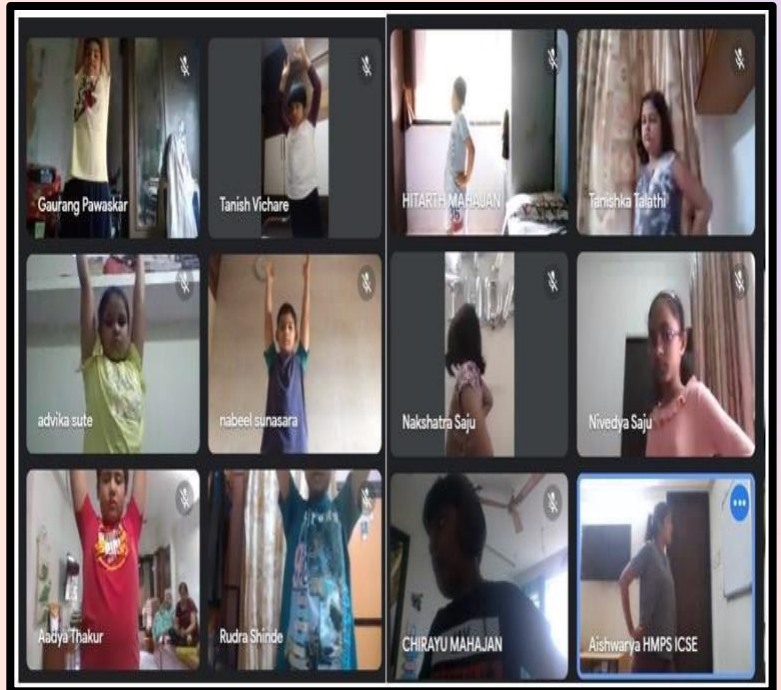


Fitness

A fitness regime helping the mind, body and soul coordination for our children in their early years.

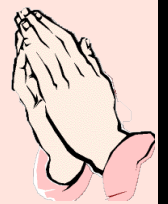


Creative fun: Engaging children in creative pursuits builds and enhances their vivid imagination.
