- Please leave according to the dispersal announcements to collect your child.



We are pleased to share the 'Plan Your Proxy Policy' with you. This policy outlines guidelines and procedures for continuity and effective management during teacher absences. Your support and adherence to these guidelines will greatly support our efforts to maintain uninterrupted educational quality. Please go through the policy carefully and feel free to reach out with any questions or feedback.

1. Objective of PYP Policy

- o When teachers are absent for any reason, their classes are covered by colleagues.
- o Coordinators/Section Heads must review substitution duties regularly to ensure no teacher works extra due to excessive substitutions.

2. Options for Teacher Absence

- o **Planned Absences:** Teachers are expected to arrange coverage for any duties that will be missed in their absence. This involves arranging for another teacher to swap classes or perform other duties. Substitute lesson plans and class instructions should be emailed/WhatsApp to the respective coordinator/supervisor/section head for use by the substitute teacher.
- o **Unexpected Absences:** The teachers must share the substitution (which teacher will cover the class as per the timetable and availability of the teacher) with the section heads in case of unplanned leave along with the work to be done.
- o In cases where the teacher is incapacitated or out of contact, the respective section heads will assist in organizing class coverage.

3. Work to be Done During the Substitution Class

- o Every teacher must be prepared for their subject's next 2-3 weeks.
- o If students do not have their subject notebooks/textbooks, the substitute teacher should execute the class using worksheets, PPTs, or video lectures (link provided by the teacher).
- o The coordinators or section head can allocate the class teacher to create a folder on the drive for each grade called the 'Substitution Folder – Grade ...' where all subject teachers will include necessary materials. (Optional).

4. Worksheet Bank

- o Extra worksheets can be prepared subject-wise for each grade, with at least 5-10 worksheets ready in advance.
- o If a worksheet is used, a new one should be prepared within a day or two to maintain a set of 5-10 worksheets.
- o Worksheets for General Knowledge or logical thinking can be included.
- o Printing of worksheets is not required unless specifically directed by the absentee teacher. Worksheets can be displayed via a projector, and students can work in their notebooks.

5. For Teachers Teaching the Same Class

- o Teachers can conduct revision or new work for their subject, depending on whether students have the required books.
- o Extra worksheets from the worksheet bank can also be given.

6. For Teachers Not Teaching the Same Class

- o Extra worksheets from the worksheet bank or games can be used.

7. Allocation by Teachers Doing a Swap

- o For planned leave, teachers should adjust their lectures/periods with those teaching the particular class.

- o Missed lectures can be taken before or after the leave day by swapping periods. This adjustment should be completed within the same week if possible.
- o Any issues with lecture adjustments should be reported to the section heads.
- o Teachers must inform the section head via email/WhatsApp and write the respective adjustments in the substitution book a day before the planned leave.

8. Rescheduling Missed Classes

- o The section heads and teacher must ensure that any lessons missed due to absenteeism are covered. Alternative make-up opportunities should be provided to students unable to attend the rescheduled class.
- o Teachers must reclaim their lecture from the substitute teacher within the week. Any adjustment issues should be reported to the section heads.

The policy will be in effect from 1 August 2024. Feel free to connect in case of any queries you may have.
